

Project ‘Photovoice: a Window on Sexual and Emotional Rights of Migrant People’

Sexual and emotional health is a component essential for human development and welfare, present at all stages of life. In all cultures there are significant differences in respect for this right, particularly for the migrant people, who faces a number of challenges: lack of access to sex education and the health care system, cases of gender-based violence, discrimination and prejudice.

For this reason, during the next 12 months, from the NGO Asociación Por Ti Mujer ONGD, the project “**Photovoice: a Window on Sexual and Emotional Rights of Migrant People**” will be carried out, in the framework of the **European Social Fund ERASMUS+ KA204 Call**, aimed at supporting the development, transfer or implementation of innovative practices and the implementation of joint initiatives to promote cooperation, peer learning and exchange of experiences at the European level.

The project will be developed with the participation of several partner entities from all over the European Union that work for inclusion of migrants, specifically from **Programma Integra Societa Cooperativa Sociale** (Italy), **Arab Women’s Solidarity** (Belgium), **Centre Accueil Consultation Information Sexualité** (France) and **Femmes Entraide Et Autonomie** (France), under the coordination of Asociación Por Ti Mujer.

Through this project, it seeks to make visible the experiences of the migrant population in relation to their sexual and emotional rights from their own photographic discourses, through the Participatory Action Research technique called “**Photovoice**”, which is aimed at promoting community empowerment processes and social transformation from a critical thinking perspective.

To this end methodological training will be given to the representatives of the collaborating entities, so that each of them, including the Asociación Por Ti Mujer, can carry out a Photovoice process with their users. The result obtained in each of the processes will be displayed by the entities in their respective countries, through a traveling exhibition open to the public, political and institutional actors.

In this way, next June, the **International Meeting for the Exchange of Good Practices in Photovoice Processes** will be held in Valencia, where the tools used will be shared and the results obtained in each of the processes will be contrasted, and these will be compiled in a **Guide of Good Practices**, published by Asociación Por Ti Mujer.
